

CUSTOMISED PROGRAMMES FOR GRASSROOTS LEADERS

1. Annual Constituency Workplan (ACWP) Retreat

The Annual Constituency Work Plan (ACWP) is a milestone event where grassroots leaders would come together as a team to deliberate on and chart out their constituencies' strategic directions and deliverables for the upcoming year. It is also a platform for the grassroots leaders in the constituency to strengthen bonds, share ideas and co-create a common vision so that members would be moving in the same direction.

NACLI provides consultancy and facilitation service for ACWP sessions with the aim to support constituencies in their work planning process and co-create shared understanding of how the PA's strategic directions and key focus areas for Community 2020. Through the facilitation process, constituencies will be engaged in various learning activities, discussions reflections and sharing to reinforce the importance of growing networks and strengthening resident engagement within their communities.

The ACWP can be conducted at the NACLI campus or at your preferred location. It can range from a half-day session to an overnight stay in NACLI.

2. Teambuilding Programmes

Based on its team building framework, NACLI offers team building programmes that take teams through various experiential activities and reflection processes to draw out learning on how to optimise team effectiveness.

Through our team building course, new and existing teams will learn to:

- ✓ Identify their current stage of team development,
- ✓ Clarify their team purpose, roles, and goals,
- \checkmark Appreciate the value of open communication, and
- ✓ Examine the key characteristics that will enable them to function as a performing team.s

All team building programmes require at least **one full day**.



3. Constituency-based Training

Training can be conducted at the constituency for grassroots leaders from the same division. Training can be contextualised for the constituency for greater learning effectiveness. Where appropriate, a practicum could also be included so that participants could show how they could put their learning into practice.

4. Talks and Dialogues

Talks and dialogues are organised regularly so that grassroots leaders could better understand government policies and give feedback to agencies on ground concerns faced by residents.
