Named after Lieutenant-Colonel Ronald MacPherson, resident councillor of Singapore under the East India Company from 1860 to 1867, MacPherson is one of the first housing estates built in Singapore. A modest neighbourhood with a strong community spirit, many of the residents grew up in the estate and carry fond memories of the people and places.

OLD MEETS NEW

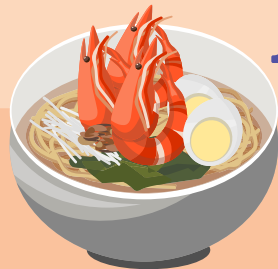
📍 Mountbatten SMC

1 GEYLANG SERAI MALAY MARKET AND FOOD CENTRE

📍 1 Geylang Serai

At the heart of the Geylang Serai, you can find Geylang Serai Malay Market and Food Centre known for its variety of authentic Malay fares. Be sure to sink your teeth into traditional *Putu Piring* kuehs filled with warm *gula melaka* and try dishes like *Beef Rendang*, a rich and flavourful coconut beef stew.

2 CIRCUIT ROAD MARKET AND FOOD CENTRE

📍 79A Circuit Road

Located at blocks 79A and 79 along Circuit Road, Circuit Road food centre is a linear stretch consisting of 100 different stalls. Dig into a delicious full-flavoured *Laksa* bowl or fragrant *Fried Oyster Omelette* and complete your hearty meal with some crispy *Pisang Kepok*!

3 OLD AIRPORT ROAD FOOD CENTRE

📍 51 Old Airport Road

Made up of numerous mouth-watering dishes, this east-side hawker centre offers many gems for food enthusiasts. Sample *Wanton Mee*, a noodle dish with Chinese dumplings and fried *Kway Teow*, stir-fried flat noodles covered in a flavourful sauce.

4 RESTAURANTS AT JALAN RIANG

📍 Jalan Riang

Known for its rustic charm, Jalan Riang is a row of shophouses that offer many different foods. From scrumptious seafood dishes to delicious chocolate desserts, a full course dinner awaits you at Jalan Riang.

5 EAST COAST LAGOON FOOD VILLAGE

📍 1220 East Coast Parkway

Hungry after a dip in the sea? East Coast Lagoon Food Village is a beachside hawker centre that offers up the best local dishes for foodies to indulge in. Served with a generous amount of *sambal* and a side of *cincalok* (fermented prawn sauce), the *Sambal Stingray* dish is a highly recommended local delicacy.

6 MARINE PARADE CENTRAL MARKET AND FOOD CENTRE

📍 84 Marine Parade Central

Known for its affordable local favourites, Marine Parade Central Market and Food Centre is a neighbourhood gem that houses well-loved food stalls that have been around for over 20 years! Can't decide on what to have for lunch? You'll be spoilt for choices here with their variety of cheap yet delicious local food.

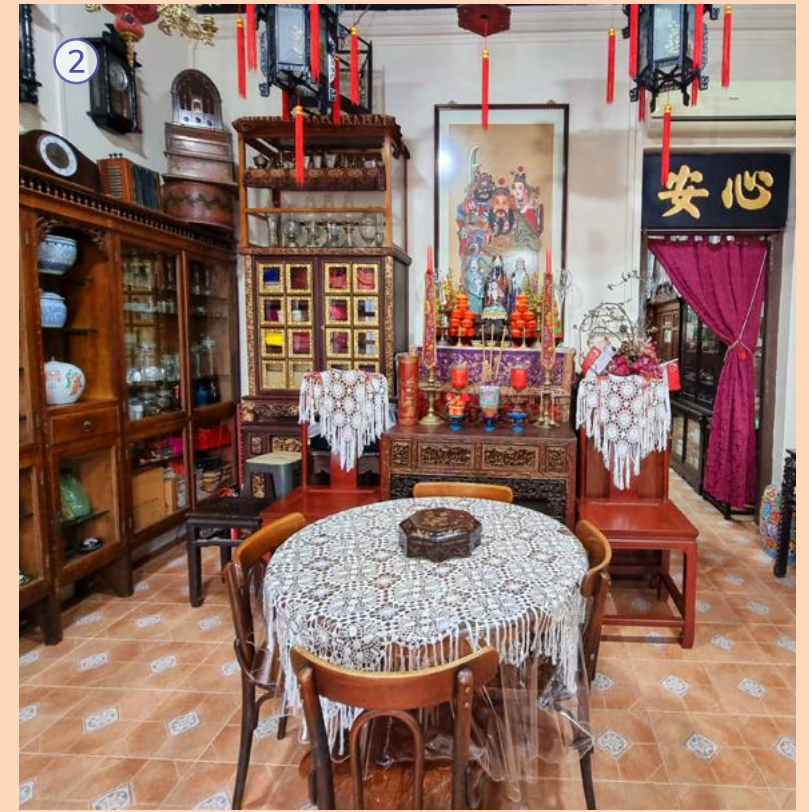

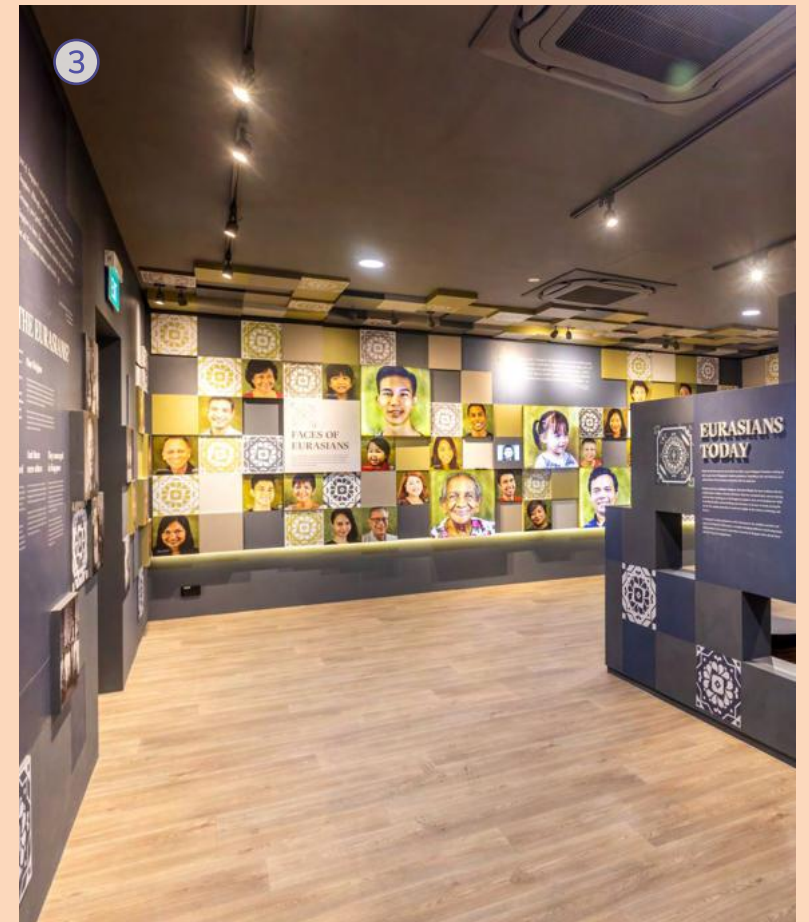

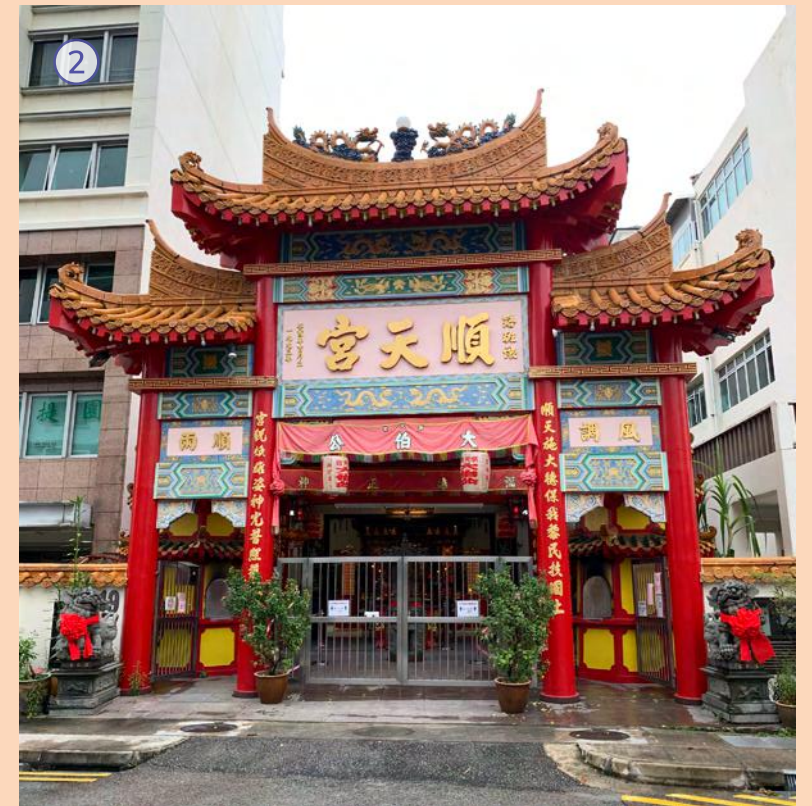

1 EAST COAST ROAD

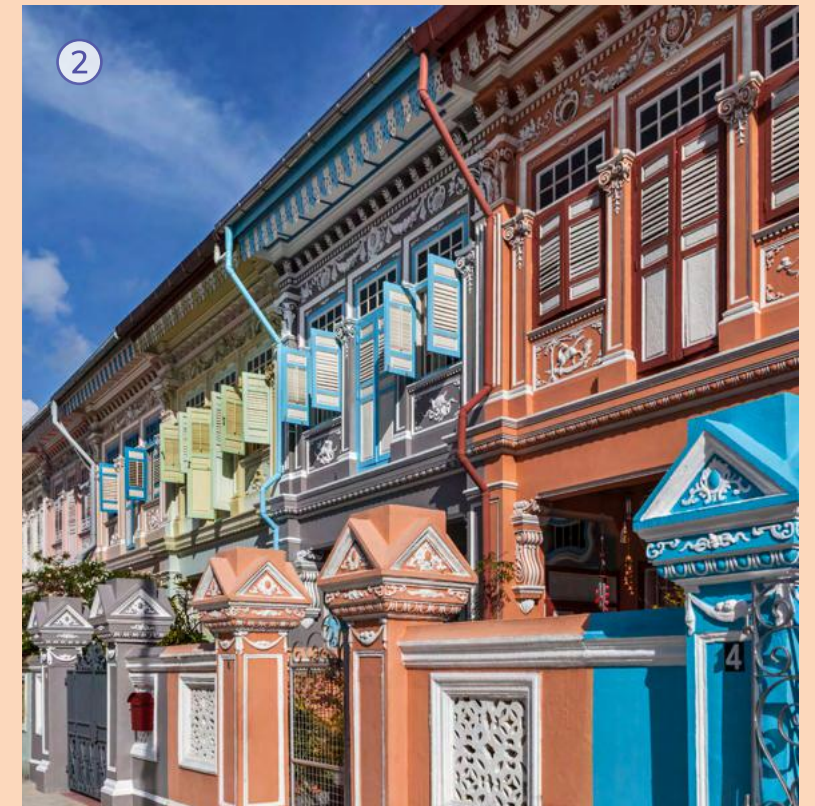
Start your journey with the beautifully drawn murals along East Coast Road.

Shelters, stilts and posts that are found along the Geylang river reflect the area's past as a notable Malay water village. Come feel the cool breeze against your skin as you stroll past the Geylang River!



4 PAYA LEBAR QUARTER

End your stroll at Paya Lebar Quarter, where you can sit around a water fountain and enjoy a refreshing drink while experiencing the outdoor breeze and sun shining down on you.

Look out for the Park Connector Network (PCN)!

This path continues into other neighbourhoods through an island-wide greenery network known as the Park Connector Network. Look out for the PCN signages and maps as you navigate your way along the roads, scenic rivers and canals that link you to the major parks. WISMA GEYLANG SERAI

📍 Geylang Serai

Learn more about the Malay culture and community at Wisma Geylang Serai. The community, civic and cultural centre regularly hosts cultural and community events such as bazaars, performances and

movie screenings. You can find the Geylang Serai Community Club, Geylang Serai Heritage Gallery, Family Service and Child Care Centre and many more groups and facilities here.



Wisma Geylang Serai reflects the history of the Geylang Serai neighbourhood as one of Singapore's oldest Malay settlements. If you look closely, architectural elements of the building take inspiration from the former Malay Village. The double-pitched roof of Wisma Geylang Serai is influenced by traditional Malay houses.



HARI RAYA LIGHT UP AND FESTIVITIES

📍 Geylang Serai

From mid-April to early June, the roads Sims Avenue and Changi Road are brightened with festivities and colourful lights in celebration of Hari Raya Puasa. The celebration of forgiveness, fellowship and food typically takes place in late March or early June, marking the end of Ramadan, the Muslim fasting month. This is the perfect time to experience Malay culture so look out for cultural programmes in the neighbourhood!

During Hari Raya Puasa, Malay families in Singapore put on ethnic clothes of the same hue. They make their way to the mosque where special prayers are recited before visiting their parents to ask for forgiveness for the wrongs they have committed in the year. Following this, they visit relatives and friends, socialising over scrumptious home-cooked spreads.
