3 FOOD ALONG PUNGGOL EAST Q 60 Punggol East

If you are searching for some place out of the ordinary, stop by at this eating outlet after a leisurely walk. The standalone eating outlet offers everyone's favourite fried chicken and an assortment of cheesecake. There are even bicycle parking facilities for cyclists who want a quick caffeine fix!

THE PUNGGOL SETTLEMENT ♀ 500 New Punggol Road

The Punggol Settlement is a food cluster offering bespoke dining options. Situated at the northeast seafront, it offers an atmospheric and stunning night view surrounded by nature.

DISCOVER SIGHTS

If you enjoy soaking in the sun and feeling the cool breeze against your skin, come discover these sights and take scenic walks while basking in the beauty of your neighbourhood.





SUNGEI API API ♥ Enter via Pasir Ris Drive 3, Riverina and Elias Road

The mangroves along Sungei Api Api, had been a resource of timber and fish for kampong residents in the area. Today, sections of the mangroves along the river have been preserved since the 1980s. Take a walk and soak in the biodiversity of the mangroves!

2 PUNGGOL POINT PARK 9 Punggol Point Road

The park is an idyllic starting point for the Punggol Promenade Punggol Point Walk. Along the walk, take in the greenery and biodiversity of the coast as you stroll along Punggol Beach. Look out for the various viewing decks and a sand-filled playground!

3 PUNGGOL POINT JETTY ♀ Punggol Point Road

The Punggol Point Jetty is a popular spot for fishing and a leisurely afternoon. Today, this jetty makes for a great end point where you can cap off your cycling trip with a sunset or a night view of the Straits of Johor.

BRIDGES OF PUNGGOL WATERWAY

Numerous pedestrian bridges span the Waterway provide distinct landmarks, exceptional views and opportunities to spot wildlife!

A JEWEL BRIDGE

The bridge features a jewellike structure and is the perfect spot to catch the sunset!

B ADVENTURE BRIDGE

This is a suspension bridge by design, with a steel structure that is built to blend into the park surroundings.

C KELONG BRIDGE

A bridge inspired by kelongs, offshore fishing platforms with stilts, that characterise the fishing platforms of the past.

D WAVE BRIDGE

This functional bridge is located near Oasis Terrace, a seven-storey HDB offering lifestyle, shopping and dining amenities.

E SUNRISE BRIDGE

This bridge marks the eastern end of Punggol Waterway. As the name suggests, it is an ideal location to catch the sunrise!

2 PRAWNING ACTIVITY 9 Various locations

Two popular prawning spots are located at Pasir Ris Town Park and Tebing Lane. Since prawns are smaller and struggle less than fishes, they are a good alternative if you wish to catch your own seafood. Grab your family and friends for a unique get-together!

3 SPLASH @ KIDZ AMAZE

9 Sentul Crescent, SAFRA Punggol

Singapore's first and largest indoor water playground that spans 23,000 square feet and overflowing with interactive play elements, five slides and eight play decks interconnected with climbing structures. Parents and their little ones will have a splashing good time!

4 GALLOP STABLE @ PASIR RIS Q 61 Pasir Ris Green

For anyone looking for activities off-the-beaten track, Gallop Stable is the place for you! Situated in the Pasir Park, this stable promises the unique experience of picking up horseriding leisurely. They offer riding lessons, pony rides and feeding, trail rides, riding camps amongst other offerings!

5 WILD WILD WET Q 1 Pasir Ris Close

Wild Wild Wet is one of Singapore's largest water parks nestled within Downtown East. It remains one of the most popular attractions in the vicinity and was voted Top 5 Water Parks in Asia under TripAdvisor Travellers' Choice in 2019 and 2020.

6 PASSION WAVE @ PASIR RIS Q 125 Elias Road

Located in Pasir Ris Park, PAssion Wave offers unique water sports like dinghy sailing, kayaking and abseiling and sports climbing. Since the waters between Pasir Ris and Pulau Ubin are calm, it is a great lifestyle destination for beginners!

2 PASIR RIS PARK

Q Enter from Pasir Ris Road Pasir Ris Green and Pasir Ris Drive 3

Pasir Ris Park covers an area of 70 hectares with tranquility ideal for families. Visitors can look forward to activities such as pony rides, water sports, cycling and nature walks along the Mangrove Boardwalk!

3 PUNGGOL WATERWAY PARK Sentul Crescent

My Waterway@Punggol is Singapore's longest man-made waterway. With its birds, bridges and picturesque views, the park offers a green respite for residents to be rejuvenated by nature.

4 LORONG HALUS WETLAND Near Pasir Ris Farmway 3

Lorong Halus Wetland safeguards the quality of water in Serangoon reservoir through a unique water bio-treatment system using plants as part of the treatment process. Enjoy the scenic view as you learn about the science behind the process!

This park is a slice of greenery within Pasir Ris. It is a popular gathering spot for residents for cultural and social activities with its wide-open space, fitness corner and playground.



2 PASIR RIS PARK MANGROVE BOARDWALK

Situated in Pasir Ris Town Park, the boardwalk offers an opportunity to get up close to the inhabitants of the mangrove forest. Keep a lookout for fireflies in the evening!




CONNECT WITH YOUR COMMUNITY

ONE PUNGGOL Punggol

Slated to open in late 2022, One Punggol is Singapore's latest integrated lifestyle and community hub which houses a five-storey regional library, a 700-seater hawker centre, childcare facilities and a community club. The hub features rooftop barbeque pits, 8,000 sqm of facilities, including a Punggol Green, a linear green park where adults can stay healthy with their fully equipped fitness stations while children have fun at the playground. With the lush rooftop gardens, One Punggol aims to create a vibrant and energetic community that thrives through a sustainable environment.



ONE COMMUNITY FIESTA PASIR RIS Pasir Ris

One Community Fiesta (OCF) is an annual event organised by Pasir Ris-Punggol GRC and Punggol West SMC Grassroots Organisations (GROs), Integration and Naturalisation Champions (INCs), and other community partners.

The event aims to bridge the gap between the locals and new immigrants in the community. It gives everyone an opportunity to bond and form new friendships as the new immigrants learn more about Singapore's rich and diverse cultures, local festivals and celebrations. Over the years, thousands of residents in the neighbourhood flock to the carnival to watch dance performances, play games, and try cuisines of different ethnic groups.

After receiving feedback from Punggol West residents about the lack of masks for children, the volunteers banded together to do more. They put the word out and received an overwhelming response. It was extremely heartening to see people giving their all to help—tracing templates, cutting fabric and sewing masks. MSWL is truly an initiative for the community by the community. As of July 2021, over 400,000 masks have been sewn and distributed nationwide.

MEET Mdm Norizan Binte Md Yusof THE DEDICATED LEADER

Norizan is a dedicated volunteer who has been volunteering long-term at her local mosque. As a Grassroots Leader (GRL), Norizan deeply sympathises with the plight of older residents living in Punggol since they generally live alone without familial support. In response, she takes the initiative to encourage older residents to join her for porridge packing with the belief that they will benefit from the chance to interact with each other. In view of the many isolated seniors in the community, she also urges other community and grassroots volunteers to brainstorm better ways to engage seniors.
